Working with our partner the Point Foundation, our focus turned to improving

the welfare of Rwandan children, living in the communities surrounding the coffee & tea plantations where we buy our beans and leaf from. Around 3,500 children (many with special needs or disabilities) have now benefited from our programmes.

Our love for coffee & provenance goes well beyond the beans in the bag; it embraces the whole essence of the aroma, taste & the simple enjoyment of just relaxing & drinking a cup of very special coffee. The fusion of two different cultures coming together to blend a coffee that is unique & magical.
